Greetings from the Trustees, Management and the Children at Tumaini Children's Home, Mombasa.

Tumaini Children's Home Trust Deed was registered on 16th December 2002 in Mombasa with a noble object "It is intended by means of an appeal for subscriptions, donations and bequests to establish a home to provide treatment and accommodation for children suffering from Human Immune Deficiency Virus and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome". On two donated plots there exists today:

The **Tumaini Children's Home** a complete **two story building** with all facilities conducive to good living for the 58 children who are housed there.

The **Tumaini Clinic with a modern laboratory** which caters for the children of the home and also for the neighbouring community on a charitable basis at subsidized rates.

The **Sirio School** providing education from Baby class, Kindergarten and Primary School upto Class 8 for the home children and is also open to the public at very reasonable fee.

The purpose of the **Clinic and the School** to be run on a subsidized fees is to win the hearts of the community most of who are low income earners. It is also an opportunity for our children to integrate and be accepted by the community.

The Tumaini Children's Home has no income and is reliant on donations both local and from overseas well wishers. The home is truly fortunate to have Tumaini Waisenhaus Förderverein (TWFV) as one of our major donors. They have been the most consistent donors without whose help the home would have closed and the children could have been on the street.

This year 5 children who graduated from Class 8 needed to go to High School. Their choice to attend a Boarding School so that they get an opportunity to integrate with other children, learn to live and take care of themselves reflects their intention to be independent. We must also appreciate the fact that they have not had a normal start in live being orphaned on the one hand and then also some of them being inflicted with Immune Deficiency Syndrome. Our estimated cost per child per year is Kes. 125,000/= which is about Euro 1,250/=. This is to acknowledge with gratitude that through Dr. Beatrix Wiebe we received a handsome contribution of Euro 5,000 to start with for their education raised by the children of your school. This is amazing and these children must be complimented and thanked for this noble gesture in making a difference to the lives of children far away from home they have not met or seen. Please convey these sentiments to them.
