

# ACADEMIC REPORT - Compiled by Kenneth Ochieng Dan Machabe.

Following the abrupt closure of schools across the country due to global pandemic, COVID 19, we resorted to online learning using the available and newly acquired electronic devices, which helped us to access learning materials and attended online classes with their teachers.

Learning groupings were organized in the upper TV hall. Groupings were done according to their grades/classes. They were as follows: Pre-primary, Grade 1-4, Class 5-6, Class 8 (2021 candidates).

We have three pupils who are learning at MM SHAH in class 7; P N, E M & F W. They were provided with an IPAD by the school for their online classes.

For the class eight candidates, M W and J N, and the high school student, S Z, were using the home laptops for their online classes and assignments. Other grades were attended to physically.

After the official confirmation by the government of Kenya that the schools are in a position to reopen, we secured them learning places at P.C.E.A Bamburi Academy for the primary pupils where they were admitted after doing their entry exams. Their term 2 welcome assessment will be released by the school examination department on 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 thereafter will be discussed with the parents/guardians.
